



There's a key to driving a sports car. It's called Precision. Especially when it comes to driving a Porsche. Our two day Precision training, which is aimed at drivers of any Porsche model, helps you to attain this level of accuracy – and drive more safely. It also provides you with the ideal preparation for the next level up: Performance.

The first day of training focuses on how to handle the vehicle. Under expert instruction, you will learn how to approach and tackle bends correctly.

At the same time, attention is paid to the potential dangers of everyday road traffic. Particularly important factors here are

learning to estimate speed and being able to react quickly. You will practise taking evasive action and experience the effect that even slight differences in speed can have on the intensity of load changes, gradually simulating driving conditions in which the vehicle threatens to oversteer.

In addition to an individual driving style assessment, the course also includes detailed and thorough coverage of the basics.

The programme on the second day of training features an appealing module where drivers can complete full laps of the circuit. There's plenty of time for practising

accurate steering, skilful braking and careful acceleration. Courses at Porsche Leipzig also include Porsche Human Performance Coaching, a special 'Offroad' session and a guided tour of the factory.

You know all about the performance of a Porsche. But what about your capabilities? If you have already completed the Precision level, it's time for the next stage en route to enhanced driving skills: our two day training is the ideal opportunity to expand your limits. In a Porsche Panamera, Cayenne or Macan, for instance.

This driving safety course mainly concentrates on further improving your vehicle control. Participants should possess certain basic knowledge, such as how to find the most suitable seat position, develop optimum vision control and respond correctly when the vehicle threatens to

oversteer at low speeds. Then we increase the pace – and your safety at the wheel.

In addition to a theory session geared towards performance driving and advanced exercises on driver safety, the first day includes a chance to familiarise yourself with the respective sequence of bends and find the optimum line. Intensive sections aim at further improving your command of the vehicle, lap after lap. Accurate and effective braking when entering a corner and avoiding unnecessary steering inputs are primarily a question of practice. One of the main on-road training modules is lapping, which is given further attention during this course.

Here, you have an opportunity to finely hone your skills over the entire circuit.

Porsche Sport Driving School instructors monitor your driving throughout and assess your progress at the end. However, here too, the emphasis is on improving your ability rather than driving at high speed.

You must have completed a Performance training course before you can take part in the next level up – the Master course.

This course is perfect for any Porsche enthusiast who has successfully completed several training courses at the Porsche Sport Driving School. You can look forward to continuing to hone your skills with other experienced participants. Under the guidance of experienced professionals. Included in the programme: a Porsche works driver, and our instructors, all of whom are experienced in racing. Participation in high-performance vehicles is not essential, but highly recommended.

You are already an accomplished driver, so we don't need to cover the basics. Instead,

we can focus on showing you how to drive more independently and quickly find your way around the track without the aid of cones and instructors. Naturally, this also includes identifying and following the racing line. You'll also discover how this can be developed still further.

Training is conducted in small groups and performance is analysed using video and data recordings.

You'll also have plenty of time out on the track to put what you've learned into practice and continue to improve your

skills – you'll even receive one-to-one guidance on some laps of the circuit.

In addition, a workshop covering both theoretical and practical aspects will teach you all you need to know about the chassis and tyres to enable you to transfer the power of your vehicle to the road in the most efficient way. Another highlight: the passenger rides in a Porsche 911 GT3 Cup (subject to availability).

Even better than watching live racing action from the stands is taking to the track yourself. In a Porsche sports car. At the Porsche Sports Cup, for instance, our customer racing series. Your optimum preparation for this: participation in the Master RS training at the Porsche Sport Driving School. It covers motorsportoriented aspects such as race etiquette, racing flags and racing attire.

The 'Porsche Human Performance' factor is now an established part of our Master RS training at Porsche Leipzig. You will be shown the exercises that will help prepare you for the typical demands of motorsport.

The driving programme includes identifying and following the racing line, precision braking and controlled acceleration out of a bend. Special attention is also given to safe overtaking manoeuvres and performing 'standing' and 'flying' starts. When driving laps, you should be able to find the optimum line over the entire course. To maximise learning, at the training courses in Leipzig, for example, your performance on the FIA-compliant circuit will be recorded on video and analysed in the group.

Undoubtedly one of the highlights on this course is the presentation of a Porsche 911 GT3 Cup vehicle, in which you also get to take several fast laps as a passenger.

Instructors with racing experience who have been specially certified by the German Motor Sport Association (DMSB) are on hand to reveal some of the tricks of the trade. The team also includes a guest instructor from the world of professional racing or a Porsche works driver. As the content of the training has been approved by the DMSB, participants who have successfully completed the course can apply to the DMSB for the national A licence* and continue to develop their racing skills.

Our special training for everyone who wishes to discover the fascinating appeal of Porsche on the racetrack: Warm-up. The course is aimed primarily at participants who do not own a Porsche. A chance for the driver to explore the vehicle, bit by bit. On section after section of the track. And corner after corner.

The course teaches you the fundamentals of vehicle control. These practice sessions take place at dedicated safety driving centres or on the racetrack.

Our shared goal: simulating hazardous situations you may face in everyday traffic at various speeds and experiencing the performance of a selection of Porsche models provided. You practise how to brake effectively, change lanes and control oversteer and understeer. In further sections, you find and follow the racing line and practise negotiating a slalom sure-footedly.

Our professional Porsche instructors will then familiarise you with the basic laws of physics relating to driving and vehicle handling. The course also covers various
Porsche electronic driving aids and how
these should be used correctly. Depending
on the venue, the 'Onroad' courses may
also include a special 'Offroad' session, a
road tour or a guided tour of the factory.

A Porsche works driver is on hand throughout to offer guidance.

At the start of your training, you learn how to handle your vehicle correctly and how to respond appropriately to hazardous situations.

Practical exercises in small groups help to ensure that you maintain control of your vehicle at all times. You will be accompanied throughout by our instructors, all of whom have been certified by the DMSB.

The second training unit focuses on the S curve: you will practise specifically how to find the optimum line through a sequence of bends, thereby improving your command of the vehicle.

You then familiarise yourself with the key motorsport-oriented aspects of the training, focusing on elements such as race etiquette and racing flags, while Porsche Human Performance Coaching takes care of your physical fitness. The driving programme includes precision braking and controlled acceleration out of a bend.

On the finishing straight, it's time to clear the last hurdle before obtaining your licence: the final theory test set by the DMSB.

In the theory session, you learn the physical principles of dynamic cornering and how to regain control if the car threatens to oversteer. You then get to put what you have learned into practice out on the track and in various sections, largely to minimise wear

and tear, on smooth surfaces with different friction coefficients. Guided by our experienced instructors, you will be introduced to the high art of vehicle control, drift after

Whether you wish to simply enhance your command of the vehicle and learn how to avoid oversteer or to perfect your controlled drift throughout a sequence of bends, both demand a precise interplay of steering, accelerating and braking. In short: practice, practice, and yet more practice.

In a series of sections, you therefore focus on specific driving skills in order to further improve your vehicle control. You learn how to use and perfect the load-changing reactions for dynamic driving, thereby maintaining control in any scenario. Data Recording

Why just keep the memory of your best moments on the track in your head? Data recording enables you to analyse your driving performance afterwards on your own PC.

Here's how it works: a data and video recording system installed in the vehicle uses a GPS sensor to determine vehicle parameters such as acceleration or deceleration. You can use this to graphically evaluate the route you have taken. Compare your selected racing line, for instance, with reference data from previous drives and benefit from an objective analysis of your driving style.

Simply take all of the recorded data and video sequences home with you on a USB memory stick. You can then use these as a reference when developing your skills on your next driver training course.

The system can either be installed in a Porsche hire car or in your own vehicle. This offer is only available in conjunction with the services of a personal instructor and is recommended for Performance, Master or Master RS and Super Sport levels in particular.


Covering 780 hectares, the modern proving ground in Papenburg is the world's largest test centre for passenger cars and commercial vehicles of all makes. Situated close to the Dutch border in Emsland, the facility is virtually cut off from the outside world. Due to the variety of vehicle tests carried out here, great importance is placed on ensuring high levels of security.

Highlights include a replica of the Hockenheimring for an authentic racing ambience. Other sections are used to simulate realistic road traffic scenarios, such as the US Freeway 710 in Los Angeles.









Boxberg Proving Ground (GER)

High-speed oval track

- Track length: 3.0 km
- Track width: 3.7 m

The wide range of facilities at this 94-hectare site are ideal for the comprehensive training offered by the Porsche Sport Driving School.

Running around the edge of the proving ground is a high-speed oval track with

three lanes and a banked curve, covering a total distance of 3 km. Inside this, there is a dynamic driving area, an extreme cornering course and a series of uphill tracks.

Nürburgring, Nordschleife (GER)

Track length: 20.8 kmTrack width: 10–12 m

Not without reason is the Nordschleife known as the 'Green Hell'. Built in 1927, this racetrack dates from another era, when mistakes were punished severely.

The varied and sometimes sharply undulating layout also features a number of

humps and dips. With its large difference in altitude, rapid succession of fast and medium-paced curves and relatively narrow track, the Nordschleife also calls for precise mastery of the vehicle. This is exactly what makes it a superlative racing venue, guaranteeing maximum motoring pleasure for discerning drivers.

Nürburgring, Grand Prix circuit (GER)

The Grand Prix circuit at the Nürburgring is one of the fastest and safest tracks in the world. Reconstruction at the beginning of the 1980s led to a circuit that offers variety even for experienced racing drivers due to the varying altitude and demanding chicanes. Particular challenges include the

hairpin bend after the finishing straight, which calls for braking at exactly the right point on entry and careful acceleration on exit. Or a slow 180-degree bend that leads uphill to a very fast combination of

Spa-Francorchamps is one of the most fascinating racetracks in the world thanks to its large difference in altitude of some 200 metres and the circuit layout.

Professional racing drivers love to return to the 'Ardennes roller coaster', built in 1921, which they call respectfully one of

the last classical drivers' circuits. In 1978. the so-called 'Bus Stop' chicane was installed and the circuit shortened to its present length. It is the alternating uphill and downhill sections, the most famous of which is Eau Rouge, that lend this circuit its particular fascination.

A permanent, clockwise, 4.2 km additional circuit within the boundaries of the 13.6 km historical 'Circuit des 24 Heures' racetrack, the Bugatti circuit was opened in 1965. It incorporates the start/finish straight and the Dunlop corner and chicane.

Since 1978, it has hosted the legendary 24-hour race, one of the world's longestrunning races. The Bugatti circuit is one of the most famous and most renowned racetracks in motorsport.

Circuit Paul Ricard (FR)

The Circuit Paul Ricard is known as 'Le Castellet' in racing circles due to its proximity to the town of the same name in the South of France. Completed in 1970, the track has a unique infrastructure. After an 11-month refurbishment in 2011, it is now a truly high-tech circuit.

Famous features include the 1.6-km Mistral straight. The facility also meets the highest standards when it comes to safety. With its extensive run-off areas and modern track security, it is one of the safest circuits in the world. The track offers more than 100 different combinations and can therefore be used to test vehicles under a wide range of conditions.

An absolute must for any ambitious sports car driver: the historic Autodromo in Imola. Covering a distance of 4.9 km and featuring a number of legendary corners, such as the Variante Bassa. Tamburello and Rivazza, it is guaranteed to raise the adrenaline levels of any experienced racing driver. The Autodromo Imola is one of the

most famous historic racetracks in Italy. Situated 40 km southeast of Bologna, the circuit hosted Formula One events for decades.

A racing licence takes you even closer to your goal: pole position on the starting grid.

The Porsche Sports Cup closes the gap between driving events organised by the Porsche Sport Driving School and Clubs and the one-make championships. Set up to promote amateur racing in Germany, it has become increasingly popular over recent years and celebrated its 10th anniversary in 2014.

Both road-going vehicles and Porsche sports cars modified specifically for racing can compete in various categories in the series for drivers with as well as without a racing licence. The series takes place on

six weekends of the year at prestigious racetracks such as the Nürburgring, Hockenheimring and Spa-Francorchamps in Belgium.

In the Porsche Zentrum Driver's Cup.

Porsche drivers without a racing licence can take part in regularity tests. The focus is on improving their driving skills and learning to control their own vehicles more safely. The aim of a regularity test is to achieve the most consistent lap times.

Porsche drivers with a national racing licence can also pit their strengths against

each other in various series. Vehicles with road or racing tyres compete in the two sprint races, the Sports Cup and Super Sports Cup. Other highlights include the long-distance Porsche Sports Cup Endurance race, which features compulsory pit stops and driver changes.

All drivers participating in the sprint and endurance races must have an A licence from the German Motor Sport Association (DMSB). The Porsche Sport Driving School offers all of the courses needed to prepare for this. In particular, these include the Master RS and Fast Track courses after

which you can apply for a national A licence*. Expert guidance during the Porsche Sports Cup can also be provided by Porsche Sport Driving School instructors on request (see p. 54).
